

Longtime South Florida development exec latest Hyde Park Capital director

(NYSE:JOE), a large, diversified real estate company; Rinker Group Limited (NYSE:RIN), a producer of construction materials in several countries; Calpine Corp. (NYSE:CPN), a producer of electric power in the United States and Canada; NCL Corp. Ltd., parent company of Norwegian Cruise Line; Edd Helms Group (PINK SHEETS: EDDH.PK), a South Florida electrical, air-conditioning and data communications service company and International Finance Bank, a **privately held Miami bank** formed in 1982.
